Display of provisional answer key(s) and question paper with recorded responses for inviting challenges to the provisional answer key(s) of CUET (PG) 2026 Examination.

1. The National Testing Agency conducted the Common University Entrance Test for Postgraduate Programmes CUET (PG) 2026 examination for 157 subjects in Computer Based Test (CBT) Mode.
2. The provisional answer key(s), for CUET (PG) 2026 examination conducted on 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19, 24, 25, 27, 29 and 30 March 2026 along with the question paper containing recorded responses are available on the website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/cuet-pg/> for candidates to challenge. The procedure for the challenge of answer key is as enclosed as Annexure-I.
3. The candidates who are not satisfied with the provisional answer key(s), may challenge the same by paying a non-refundable processing fee of ₹200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) per question challenged. The detailed schedule for submitting answer key challenges is provided below:


4. *The payment of the processing fee may be made through (through Credit Card/ Debit Card/Net Banking/UPI Payment Modes till 14 April 2026 (upto 10:00 A.M.). No challenge will be entertained without receipt of the processing fee. The Challenges will not be accepted through any other mode.*
5. Challenges made by the candidates will be verified by the panel of subject experts. If the challenge of any candidate is found correct, the Answer Key will be revised and applied in the response of all the candidates accordingly. Based on the revised Final Answer Key, the result will be prepared and declared. **No individual candidate will be informed about the acceptance/non-acceptance of his/her challenge.** The key finalized by the Experts after the challenge will be final.

Procedure for Challenge of Answer Key(s) of CUET (PG) 2026 Examination

1. Please go to NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/cuet-pg/>.
2. Click on the link 'Challenge(s) regarding Answer Key'
3. Login using their login credentials (Application Number and Password/Date of Birth).
4. Click on "View Answer Sheet" for marked responses and to view or challenge the Answer keys, click on the link Click "Challenge" button to view provisional answer keys and challenge the questions.
5. You will see Question IDs in sequential order; candidates are advised to see your question as per Question ID.

6. The ID next to the question under the column 'Correct Option(s)' stands for the most appropriate Answer Key to be used by NTA. The Dropped Questions are highlighted and not for challenge.
7. If you wish to challenge this option, you may use any one or more of the Option IDs given in the columns by clicking the check box.
8. For uploading the supporting documents, you can select 'Choose File' and upload. All supporting documents are to be in a **single PDF file**.
9. After clicking on your desired Option(s) ID for Challenge scroll down and click on 'Submit and Review Claims' and move to the next screen. You must ensure to select all the required options(s) before moving further.
10. You will see a display of all the Question ID and Option(s) you have challenged.
11. If you may still modify your selection by clicking on 'Modify Claim'. Once you have selected all the Option(s)ID for Challenge you can click on 'Save Claim and Pay Fee'.
12. After clicking on 'Save Claim and Pay Fee', candidates will be go to the payment gateway. No modification will be allowed after successful payment.
13. Click on 'Pay Now' to proceed with the payment.
14. Select mode of payment and pay a non-refundable processing fee @ Rs.200/- for each question challenged. Make payment through Debit/Credit Card/Net Banking/UPI.
15. The challenges will be considered only after successful payment of the requisite fee. No challenge will be accepted without payment.


